## REPORT

## Bentley LEARNing Conference Recap

This year instead of holding just one large conference in Philadelphia, Bentley decided to hold several smaller conferences across the country and in Europe in order to be able to serve more users worldwide. Each of the eight different conferences will focus on a different discipline for that region. One of these LEARNing Conferences took place just last week in Phoenix, AZ.

Tom Lazear of Archway attended the Phoenix LEARNing Conference last week, **June 17-18th**, which focused on **Civil** discipline. There were over 400 attendees at this event, the largest of the conferences so far!

Tuesday morning, the attendees were welcomed by Dallas Hammit, Sr. Deputy State Engineer as well as Joe Powell, Support Manager for Salt River Project which is the 3rd largest Power/Water utility in the US. Then

Dan Ahern, Civil Director in Professional Services, spoke about the power of Information Modeling and all the benefits of BIM and Information Modeling in any type of project. Ian Rosam then talked all about SS3 OpenRoads including Civil Cells, corridors, and dynamic cross sections, as well as Bentley's Subsurface Utilities Engineering. Derrick Gray also demoed SS3, showing that you can create a project model very quickly.

After the 2 hour opening presentations, the breakout sessions began. There were 52 sessions in total that attendees could choose from to be a part of. Some were just 45 minute lecture style sessions, while others were 90 minute hands on sessions. There were many options available to learn all about Bentley's products and what they're doing in the future.
