MicroStation SS4 Update Available on SELECTserver

For those users of MicroStation V8i that are still not ready to make the jump to CONNECT, there is an update of MicroStation available! **MicroStation V8i SELECTseries 4 is now available on the SELECTserver.**

This new version acts as a middle ground between MicroStation SS3 and MicroStation CONNECT. **CONNECTED Users and CONNECTED Projects** are a part of MicroStation SS4 allowing you to assign projects to CONNECTED Projects, publish i-models, and print PDF.

Some other new features include updates to data interoperability, dynamic views, hatching and patterning, i-models, printing and the raster manager. The updated data interoperability now includes support for Autodesk RealDWG 2016, Acute3D files and IFC Version 4. There are enhancements to multiple features include the Annotation Scale Setting, Publish i-models Dialog, Create Drawing Dialog, and Plan Callout. The Raster Manager now has support for Bing Maps and Printing now has support for sharing printed PDFs on the Cloud.

What Bentley is Doing for Students
